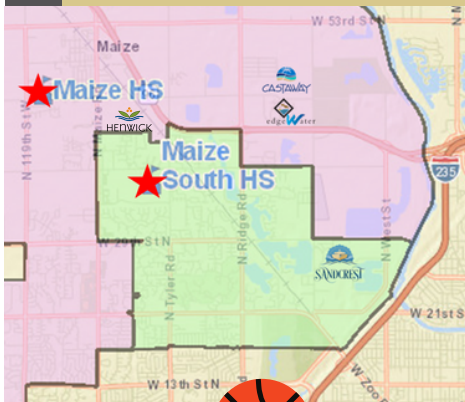
7,567 STUDENTS AS OF FALL 2021

The highly-regarded Maize school community is a rapidly-growing district originally formed in 1966. For the 2021-22 school year, there are 9 public schools serving 7,567 students in Maize School District. Maize is the 12th largest in the state encompassing just over 42 square miles with a 95% graduation rate and math proficiency rate placing the district in the top 5% in Kansas.



FACILITIES

Thanks to the support of our community, the district's new Maize Performing Arts and Aquatics Center (MPAAC) will be the first of its kind. This center will house an auditorium and swimming pool, providing new and expanded opportunities for students across the district. This project was part of the exciting \$108.2 million 2019 bond issue overwhelmingly supported by voters and designed to address growth, safety, and opportunity for all students.

Residents of Sandcrest will attend Maize South High School. Residents of Edgewater, Castaway and Henwick will attend Maize High School. Our Maize USD 266 administrative staff members have inspired student artwork, charitable cooperation, a flash mob, and more. From Eagles and Mavericks collaborating on fundraising community projects to high school students helping in our preschool classrooms, we are stronger together.



SPORTS
